

If you think you'd like to be a volunteer firefighter, you are welcome to come see what we're about. We hold a business meeting at Station 1, located at 843 Old Hwy. 92, on the first Monday of every month at 7 pm. On the third Monday, we have in-house training at 7 pm.

We ask that you attend a couple of meetings before applying to become a firefighter. This gives you a chance to meet the firefighters and get a feel for what we do.

Once your application (link on home page) has been accepted, you will go before a screening committee. You will have to pass a physical, a drug test, and a background check. When all requirements are met, you will be issued your bunker gear and radio. All new firefighters have to complete at least a 6 month probationary period. During this period, you can respond to calls but must report to Station 1 first unless the call is on your way to the station.

If you are between the ages of 16 and 18 you may apply to become a Firefighter Cadet. Upon turning 18, you will be eligible to apply for firefighter status.
